

4-year Plan Vocational Family and Consumer Science

4 credits: English (General or College Prep, Honors, or AP)

3 credits: Social Studies (General or College Prep)

3 credits: Science (General or College Prep or Honors) This includes .5 credits of Exploring Tech 2

3 credits: Math (Tech Math or College Prep or Honors or AP)

.5 credits: Safety Education

.5 credits: Health (not junior high)

2 credits: Physical Education

4.5-6 credits: Vocational Family and Consumer Science (must have minimum of 3 years Voc. Fam & Cons. Science and must take it in senior year)

2-3.5 credits Electives: will need 2 credits of electives if you take Voc. Family & Consumer Science for all 4 years, will need 3.5 credits of electives if you only take Voc. Family & Consumer Science for 3 years.

☺Remember, if you take certain college prep courses and:

If you have a 93 average in:

√Int. Math I & Int. Math II, you will qualify for Honors Integrated Math III

√Earth & Space & Biology CP, you will qualify for Honors Chemistry.

√English 8 & English 9CP you will qualify for Honors English 10.

***If you take 4 years of Voc. FCS you will only need .5 credits of electives your senior year; if you have taken only 3 years of Voc. FCS you will need 2 credits of electives your senior year.**
